The Outstanding Indiana Advisor Award was created to recognize the importance of academic advising at colleges and universities in the state of Indiana. Recipients of the award will be recognized at the annual state conference. This award will be given to either a faculty advisor or a professional advisor who has made significant contributions to the field of academic advising through the criteria outlined below. The selection committee will be made up of experienced advisors from throughout the state.

AWARD CRITERIA

The selection committee will evaluate nominations on the evidence of effective advising qualities and practices that distinguish the nominee as an outstanding academic advisor. Such evidence may include, but is not necessarily limited to, the following:

- IAAN member for at least one year
- Demonstration of a professional attitude toward advisees
- Effective interpersonal skills
- Availability to advisees
- Evidence of active involvement in helping students achieve career and academic goals
- Use of information resources and referral agencies
- Evidence of professional development such as attendance at seminars and professional conferences
